Hamad Medical Corporation confirms that all temporary staff employed at the Qatar Vaccination Center for Business and Industry Sector - which opened on 9 January 2022 - have received their salaries in accordance with the agreed contractual terms.

Therefore, all temporary employees received their January salaries in mid-February, and the February salaries will be paid by Sunday 13 March.

HMC operates in full accordance with Qatar's labor laws. All staff employed by HMC on temporary contracts are receiving salaries based on their contract terms, which do not include end of service benefits. All overtime payments are being made for staff who are eligible.

HMC is deeply grateful to all temporary staff working at the Qatar Vaccination Center who have played a crucial role in Qatar's swift efforts to vaccinate the country against COVID-19. Many of the staff currently working at the center were previously employed at the vaccination center in the Industrial Area in 2021 and received their salaries in full without delay.
